

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES 2022-2023

Dress Code Expectations for All Students

Pants:

- Khaki, navy blue, or charcoal gray color classic dress pant
- Flat or pleated chinos, khakis, or golf pant style
- Must be worn with a belt (any color, pattern, or style of your choosing!)
- Pants should present neat and hemmed

Shorts:

- Acceptable dress code in August, September, October, April, May, and June
- Khaki, navy blue, or charcoal gray Bermuda-like shorts
- Shorts must come no higher than 2" above the top of the knee

Shirts:

- Solid or Striped collared shirt (in navy, white, light blue, or gray)
 - TSS logo optional 0
 - Polo or button-down
 - Short or long sleeve
 - Shirts must be tucked in
- White turtleneck or collared shirt under TSS fleece is acceptable
- No long-sleeve shirts under short-sleeve polos

Shoes:

- All-weather mocs
- Loafers, Oxfords, Mary Janes
- Sneakers in solid colors: navy, white, gray, or black (required on PE days)
- Dress boots may be worn from November 1st through April break, but must be changed to sneakers for PE
- For safety reasons, no backless, open-toed shoes; or UGGs of any kind

Warmth & Layering Suggestions

No hoodies of

any kind!

Fleeces

- Choices of full-zip, pull-overs, and quarter-zips
 - TSS logo required
 - Available at GlobalSchoolwear.com
 - No shoulder designs, stripes, patterns, piping, or hoods

Knit Sweaters

- Cardigans, pullovers, and sweater vests
 - TSS logo optional
 - Solid colors only: navy, gray, or black

Socks & Tights

- Socks of your choosing!
- Knee-high socks or tights must be solid colors
- Leggings are acceptable if the socks match in color and cover fully to sock

Additional Dress Code Options

Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers & Polo Dresses

- Skorts recommended on PE days
- Solid colors only: khaki, navy, light blue, or gray
- Length no higher than 3" above the center of the knee
- Anything worn underneath for warmth should not appear below the hemline
